

**Chapter G – Bird Sanctuary**  
(Amended 5/14/14)

**Article I – Established**

**Section 1. Area**

The area within the corporate limits of the Village of Whispering Pines is hereby designated as a Bird Sanctuary.

**Section 2. Native Wild Birds Protected**

In accordance with N.C.G.S. 160A-188 it shall be unlawful for any person to trap, hunt, shoot, or otherwise take any protected native wild bird, except pursuant to a permit issued by the North Carolina Wildlife Resources Commission under G.S. 113-274(c) or under any other license or permit of the Wildlife Resources Commission specifically made valid for use in taking birds within Village limits.

**Section 3. Unprotected Birds**

This ordinance shall not protect any birds classified as a pest under Article 22A of Chapter 113 of the General Statutes and the Structural Pest Control Act of North Carolina of 1995 or the North Carolina Pesticide Law of 1971.

**Section 4. Signs**

The Public Works Director shall erect signs to designate the Village of Whispering Pines a Bird Sanctuary; provided however, all such signs shall be subject to the regulations of the Village of Whispering Pines and the State Highway Commission.
